Scavenger Hunt Instructions

To get to Paris:

1. Go to the United States Mint H.I.P. Pocket Change™ Web site at:
www.usmint.gov/kids
2. Click on the "Cartoons" coin on the left of the screen.
3. Click on the "Coins of the World" icon on the right of your screen.
4. Click on the plane in the lower right hand corner of the screen.
5. When the map comes up, select France.
6. Once you are in the schoolhouse, find the plane on the bottom right of your screen, and click on it to start your trip!
7. Create a group name and type it on your passport.
8. Select a character to be your group's mascot on your passport and click on the plane to continue.
9. Once you've read the "Little Round Stories" page, **ANSWER QUESTION #1** on your Scavenger Hunt Questions worksheet.
10. On the "Little Round Stories" page, click on the plane to continue.
11. Follow the written directions on the "Exchange-o-Meter" page. When the francs pop out of the robot, select one and click on it. This will take you to the **Travel Guide** section.
12. While reading the **Travel Guide** section, **ANSWER QUESTION #s 2-9**.
13. **GOOD WORK!** Click on the plane to return to your voyage through France. Click on the plane once more at the bottom of the "Exchange-o-meter" page. Click on the plane one more time in the "Welcome to France" box and **VOILA!** Welcome to Paris!

To navigate through Paris:

1. Your group will need to visit ALL SIX of the H.I.P. Pocket Change Pals in Paris. Click on a name from the "Pals to visit" board on the right side of your screen to get to a location. Be sure to visit all six and read the information carefully!
2. Once you have visited all six locations, you will be taken to a page that says, "Time to Say Goodbye to France". Find the plane button in the bottom right corner of the screen and click on it.
3. Click on the plane in the middle of the screen when your group is ready to **take the quiz.**
4. On the quiz, select your answers by clicking on them. When you have completed, you should see an open passport with your mascot on the left side. Find the printer icon on the right side and click on it. Your passport should now print out.
5. **Be sure to give this printout and your group answer sheet to your teacher!**
